

INSTALLING

The application installs automatically onto your computer like any other Windows application. A few clicks and it's all done!

Look for the setup program icon for the application. The name will be something like **LPS Entry Preparer 1.9.3 Setup**, although the exact numbers might be different.

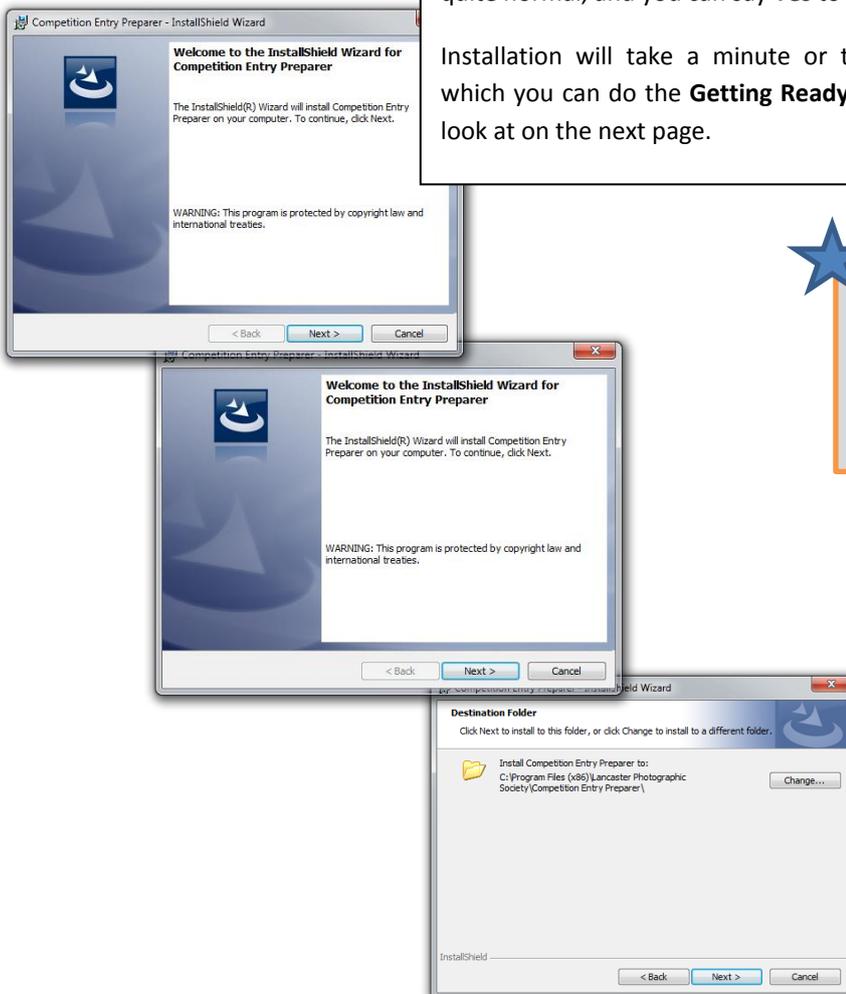
Double click on this to run it.



Then click on **Next** as you see a short succession of forms.

You'll be asked at some point if you want to allow the installer application to run – this is quite normal, and you can say **Yes** to this.

Installation will take a minute or two, after which you can do the **Getting Ready** steps we look at on the next page.



TIP: If you're using **Windows Vista**, you might see a warning that you're trying to run an application from an "unknown publisher".

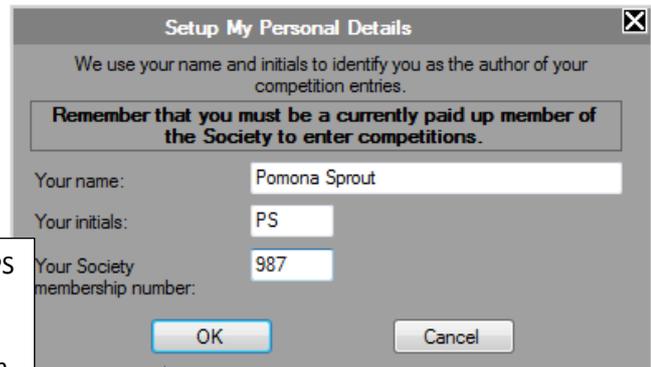
This is quite normal and expected. It's safe to tell Windows that you want to proceed.

GETTING READY

The first time you run the application, you'll need to put in some information about you, and set up the details of the society competitions. It's all done automatically with just a few clicks, and you won't have to do the steps on this page again.



You'll see this screen only on the very first time you run the application. Click the **Yes** button to get going.



First job: Tell the application who you are, and your LPS membership number.

You'll only be asked this the first time you use the application, but you can change the details any time you like.

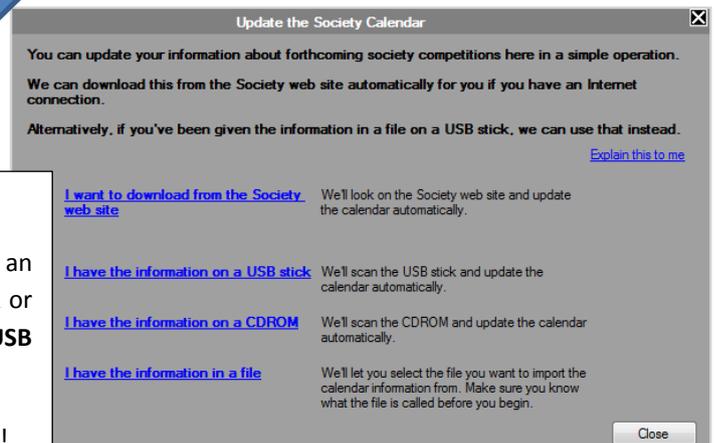
TIP: Your membership number is on the front of your printed programme for the year.



Now you need to set up the society calendar, which has the dates and details of all the year's competitions. It'll take only a couple of clicks!

You can use your Internet connection for this (the best way); or use the USB stick or CDROM you got the application on.

So click the **Yes** button, and now you'll see ...



... this form giving you the options.

Click on **Download from the society web site** if you have an Internet connection; otherwise make sure the USB stick or CDROM is online and click **I have the information on a USB stick** or **I have the information on a CDROM**.

And then all the work is done quite automatically for you!

PREPARING FOR A COMPETITION

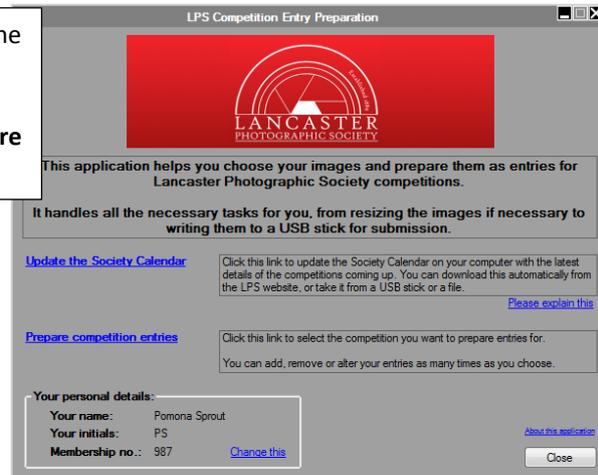
When you want to get competition entries ready, start up the application and follow the steps below.

You'll find it very easy to do – the application does all the hard work for you, so you can concentrate on the photography!

This is our main form, which can take you to all the things you need to do.

To work on competition entries, click on **Prepare competition entries ...**

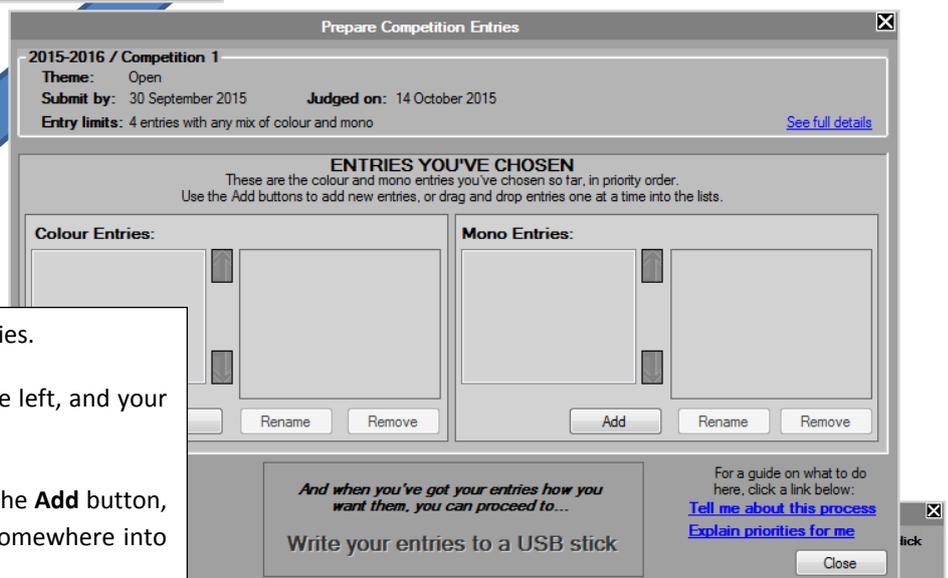
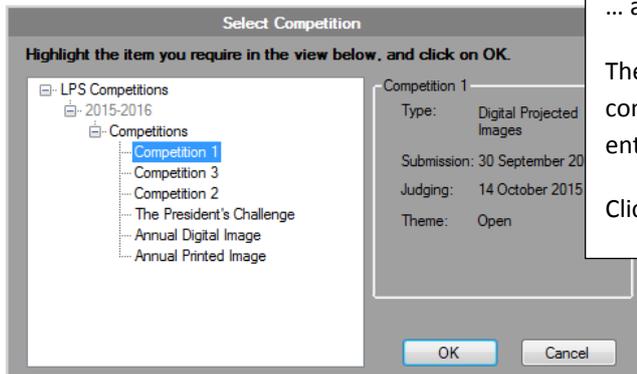
TIP: You don't need to do all the work for a competition at once. You can close the application and resume as often as you like.



... and select the competition from the society calendar.

The panel on the right tells you some details about the competition, including the last date for handing in your entries.

Click on **OK** when you've selected the competition.



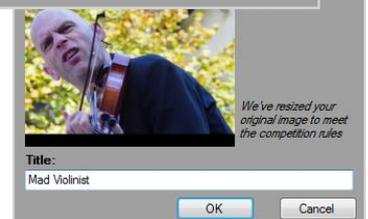
And here's the form where you add your entries.

You add your **Colour** entries in the box on the left, and your **Mono** entries on the box on the right.

Choose your images manually by clicking on the **Add** button, or drag and drop them one at a time from somewhere into the appropriate **Entries** list.

We'll ask you to give the image a title, and if the image is not correctly sized we'll do that for you.

You can add images, remove them or change their priority order until you're happy.

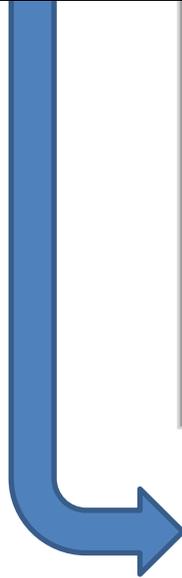
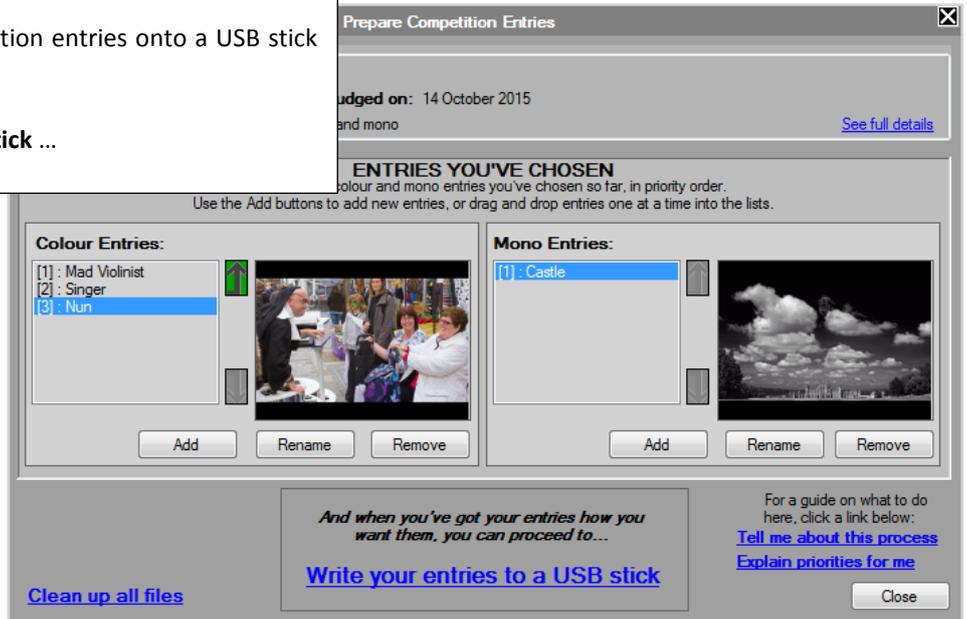




And when you're done, the form will look something like this, with your selected images in the lists with preview images.

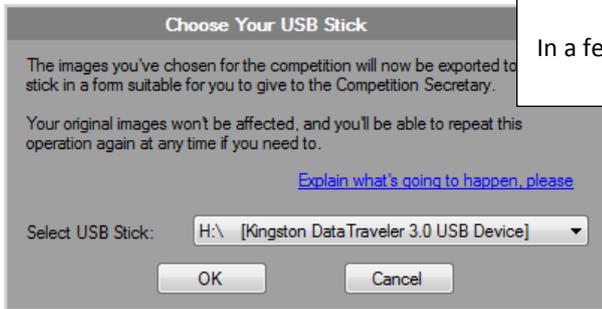
The final stage is to put your competition entries onto a USB stick to hand in.

Click on **Write your entries to a USB stick ...**



... select the USB stick you want to use, and click on **OK**.

In a few moments, it will all be done!



TIP: If you change your mind about the entries after you've done this, just go back, make the changes and then repeat the export to the USB stick. We'll remove what you did previously and replace it with your new selection.



HAVING PROBLEMS?

We don't expect you'll find any problems with the application. We've tested and used it on a wide variety of computers, but unexpected things do sometimes happen!
